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T-Shirt Quilts

We all have t-shirts from special events....school sports, clubs, hobbies, vacations, college, sororities and more... are they stacked in the closet...too special to donate...but too old to wear? Send them to us, we'll take your old t-shirts and give them new purpose. We'll piece them together with skill and the highest quality materials to make a one of a kind **t-shirt quilt**, specially made just for you.

Here's how it works:

- 1. Go through your t-shirts to determine which ones you want to use. Mark each t-shirt using the following codes so that I will know which side (or both) of the t-shirt to use:
 - F Front
 - B-Back
 - X Both
- 2. Contact us to set up an appointment to drop off your t-shirts or to let us know you are putting them in the mail. Send us your clean t-shirts, laundered with detergent NO FABRIC SOFTENER or DRYER SHEETS, please.
- 3. We will prepare, cut and assemble the t-shirts with sashing fabric, cornerstones and borders, using high quality, 100% cotton fabrics.
- 4. We will machine quilt the assembled quilt top, quilt back and batting, and bind it by machine sewing it down on the front and finishing it on the back by hand.

One price includes the labor, materials, fabric, batting, quilting and binding.

How many t-shirts do you need?

One (1) t-shirt front (or back) counts as one (1) block. Smaller graphics can be combined to make a block. T-shirt blocks are 15". Most adult size t-shirts will make a block, smaller size shirts can still be used by building them up using a coordinating fabric. An average sashing would be 3" on the smaller quilts and 2" for the Queen/King size quilts. However, sashings and borders can be adjusted to accommodate your size preference if you have too many or too few t-shirts.

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Throw size: 9 blocks (3x3) - approximate size 60"x60" (Base Price $45.00)
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Stadium size: 12 blocks (3x4) – approximate size 60"x75" (Base Price $60.00) 16 blocks (4x4) – approximate size 75"x75" (Base Price $80.00)
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Full size: 20 blocks (4x5) – approximate size 75"x90" (Base Price \$100.00)

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Queen/King size: 25 blocks (5x5) – approximate size 85"x85" (Base Price $125.00) 30 blocks (5x6) – approximate size 85"x105" (Base Price $150.00)
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Quilting terms:

block - the t shirt forms the block

sashing – the fabric between the blocks that adds visual contrast and stabilization to each block

cornerstone block – the small square that connects the sashing fabric

border - the fabric that frames the outside of a quilt

quilt back - fabric used on the back side of the quilt

quilt top – the top layer of the quilt after all the blocks, sashing and border are assembled

quilting – the stitches that go through all the layers, forming designs and securing the batting and fabric

binding - the fabric that encloses the edges around the quilt
